A issue of **Ethology Ecology and Evolution (EEE)** will be devoted to the publication of papers presented at the meeting, upon submission to a panel of referee and acceptance. **EEE** provides English language revision service, thus helping non native English speakers in publishing their papers, publication costs will be: € 10.00 per printed page (instead of € 20), colleagues asking for the Conference award (see II announcement) shall have the possibility to publish without the contribution fee, after one year from printed version publication, the issue will be available on-line as an open access journal.

EEE, published by Firenze University Press is an Open Access journal, based on the principle that knowledge diffusion in any field of science should not be constrained by commercial barriers but should be available to the most possible number of readers, without violating untouchable principles of intellectual property. Within this philosophy papers published in EEE have an open free access on line 12 months after publication. Local organisers believe that this is very much within the spirit and the aim of the marmot community.
